Tom Liu started piano at the age of 6 with Esther Chung Marks of Port Jefferson Station in 2013. He received First Class Honors with Distinction in the *Royal Conservatory Music Development Program* Level 7. His 15 and 20-piece Piano Guild International programs earned him Superior + in the "Elementary Special" category. In 2015, Tom performed at Carnegie Hall as a Grand Prix Winner in the *Concert Festival Competition* and the *Russian Music at Carnegie Hall* recital. Tom was the First Place winner in the Elementary and Early Intermediate Divisions of the *Suffolk Piano Teachers Foundation Piano Competition*.

He gives his solo recital debut today as the youngest First Prize Winner in the *Concert Festival Solo Recital Competition*. Tom is a Grand Prix Winner in the *Concert Festival*

Concerto Competition, and will make his concerto debut in May. He performed in a master class for pianist Tanya Gabrielian and will attend the prestigious Juilliard Pre-College program this fall.
