**Chang Li** started learning piano at the age of 4. In 2014 he started playing piano under the guidance of Prof. Chen Wu at Xi'an Conservatory of Music, China. During his undergraduate studies, he completed a series of chamber music concerts including piano recital. He also received scholarships every year during his undergraduate period. In 2018, Chang Li was admitted to Mannes School of Music, Manhattan School of Music, San Francisco Conservatory of Music and Music College at University of Cincinnati for Master of Music with scholarship. He performed at the Art Center of Xi'an Conservatory, Xi'an Concert Hall China, Mirasler Concert Hall in Hamburg Germany, San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Manhattan School of Music, Mannes School of Music, Lincoln Center and Carnegie Hall. Chang Li was the Silver Award winner in the Young Group of the First German Hamburg International Piano Competition, Germany in 2016. Winner of the Third Prize in the Camerata Artists International Competition in 2019. He also a Concert Festival Spring Season Grand Prix Winner of 2019. Chang Li was taught by famous American pianists, Gustavo Romero Corey Macvicar, Marc Silverman, Blair Mcmillen and Hugo Goldenzweig. Also studied piano with Dr. Yi-heng Yang at The Juilliard School in 2018. Now he is pursuing his graduate degree at Mannes School of Music as a student of Dr. Vladimir Valjarević in New York.



**Katerina Movchan** was born in Lugansk, Ukraine in 1996. As a child Katerina has been supported in her early development as a musician by the Austrian flutist Barbara Gisler-Hasse. From whom she was given her first major opportunity to play with a professional orchestra at the age of 12 under the baton of the Austrian conductor Kurt Schmidt. Later at the age of 16 Katerina left her native city and moved to Kyiv, where she was given a place to study at the Special Music School "M. V. Lysenko". She studied with the famous Ukrainian flute pedagogue V. K. Turbovsky. Later on, for perfecting her progress in music she moved to Graz, where she has been accepted at the Universität für Musik und Darstellende Kunst Graz, in the class of the world known flutist Professor Dietrich Flury, who was the principal and solo flutist at the Wiener Philharmoniker. Katerina Movchan has played in many renowned concert halls like : National Philharmonic of Ukraine, Harbin Opera House, Xinghai Concert Hall, UNESCO Concert Hall Paris, Musikverein Graz and Konzerthaus Berlin. In addition to that, Katerina performed on the international stages of Moldavia, Romania, Ukraine, Serbia, Croatia, Czech Republic, China, Italy, France, Germany and Austria.
