She was awarded the Grand Prize for both piano and violin in Music-Fest's Rising Talents Festival.

Victoria received Gold Prize for piano and Silver Prize for violin in Ivy Young Musicians Competition.

She was the First Prize Winner in American Protégé International Music Talent Competition and also won prizes in American Protégé Piano and Strings Competition and AADGT competition.

In 2014 Victoria was nominated to compete in the Miss Teen New York pageant and won the First Runner-Up prize in the Junior Pre-Teen category.

She also competed in the New York State Governor's Cup 4th International Open Tae Kwon Do Championship 2015 and won a Gold, Silver, and a Bronze medal in respective categories.

Victoria is a member of Mensa since she was 3 years old and a Davidson Young Scholar since she was 5 years old.
